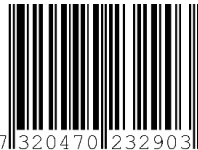

History

In the summer of 2020 this emerged into the new Black Paisley line-up as Franco decided to leave Electric Boys and go full-time with Black Paisley. The former Paisley members (Hedin, Wirensjö and Kerslow) went off to create a new rockproject called Whale Dog. At this point the band made a decision to steer in on a little different direction musically, introducing a riffier sound with more uptempo songs, without abandoning the catchy melodies that have become one of Black Paisley's hallmarks. The reformed Paisley rehearsed and recorded all summer at Franco's old friend Martin Karlegård's studio. Karlegård also played a part in the songmaking and vocal arrangements as well as doing all backing vocals along with Franco. The new album consists of 8 brand new tracks, this time back to the basic rock setup with 2 guitars and no keyboards.

The artwork "The Rambler" is made by digital artist Tanbeeed Amin and visualizes a growing spine in copper surrounded by ramling roses, describing the band evolution.
